

# Bell Tower Festival Parade

- On Site Registration begins at 8 AM, June 12.



The Bell Tower Festival parade is scheduled for Saturday, beginning at 11:00 a.m. The parade will begin at the Greene County Middle School (former high school) located at the junction of Highway 4 and Ram Drive. The entrance to the registration area will be from Highway 4.

When entering the parade registration area, please stop at the registration table and get your parade entry number. A parade committee member will direct you to your placement in the parade line-up. Your cooperation during the line-up is much appreciated.

Please complete the Parade Entry Form and be sure to fill out the "length of entry" and the number of vehicles. You will be asked to sign an insurance release on the day of the parade. No charge for parade entries through Wednesday, June 9. Entries the day of the parade will be charged a \$20.00 entry fee.

## Judging

You may choose to have your entry judged in one of three categories:

1. Commercial-business advertising/publicity
2. Non-commercial, class reunions, dance groups, floats, etc.
3. Thematic-entries that depict the theme of the festival. Judging will take place in the line-up before the parade begins. If you wish to have your entry judged please be in place before 10:00am Saturday morning on June 12<sup>th</sup>.

## Groups and Reunions

We request your vehicle and/ or flatbed arrive at the high school no later than 10:00am so we can get your entry in the parade line-up.

## Policies

As In all public events, safety is of the utmost importance to festival and parade committee. The festival reserves the right to immediately remove anyone deemed as acting in an unsafe manner during the parade. Tall entries must be able to safely navigate the parade route without touching power or telephone wires and trees.

Large trucks and floats with obstructed views must provide walking parade participants to help with safe navigation. Horse entries will be allowed in the parade only if their own cleanup crew follows them during the parade.
